How to Apply:

Application Deadlines

For applicants **outside the United States**, applications and all credentials required for admission must be received in the Office of Admissions by: **April 1** - fall (August); **September 1** - spring (January); **February 1** - summer (June)

For applicants **already in the U.S.**, there are no admissions office application deadlines. However, departments have their own particular deadlines and additional requirements (i.e. letters of recommendation, GRE or GMAT score, portfolios, etc.) for admission to their graduate programs. Please contact the academic unit in which you wish to study to receive complete information.

This application form in PDF format is designed for you to fill out on-screen, then print and mail to the University.

Or, if you prefer, you may print the application, fill it out by hand and then mail it.

No action will be taken on your application until the fee is received.

Materials to be submitted in addition to the admission application and application fee:

- An official TOEFL score report directly from the Educational Testing Service or official IELTS score report, or satisfy the English proficiency requirement in one of the other ways listed at <http://www.ou.edu/admissions/home/requirements/international.html#EnglishProficiency>.
- Bank statements and letters of financial support which are less than 90 days old to verify your financial support.
- Official, complete academic credentials (i.e., marksheets, degree certificates, transcripts, etc.).

- If you have a passport, please include a photocopy of the name page. Many academic programs require the GRE or other supporting materials, such as GMAT scores and/or letters of recommendation, before considering applications for admission. Some departments also have their own applications. These credentials should be sent directly to the department to which you are applying.

Graduate Admission Process

Office of Admissions Review - Upon receipt of your application, the Office of Admissions will verify that all materials are received and will forward your application to the Graduate College for review.

Graduate College Review - Upon satisfaction of all Graduate College requirements, the Graduate College will refer your application to the academic department and recommend you for admission.

Academic Department Review - After the academic department reviews your complete application, they will notify the Graduate College of the admission decision.

Notification of Admission Decision - The Graduate College will forward the application and admission decision to the Office of Admissions who will notify you of your admission status.

Completing the Application Form:

Name

Provide your legal name. All application materials are filed in our office alphabetically under the "last" (family) name on the application. If this is not the final word in your name, please underline, circle or capitalize it. It is extremely important that all correspondence, forms, transcripts, etc., use the same name and spelling. Materials often cannot be matched when use of the name is inconsistent.

List any other names under which your transcripts or test scores may appear.

Student Information

U.S. Social Security number is required for Internal Revenue Service reporting and financial aid, but will not be used as your permanent student identification number. You will be notified of your permanent Sooner ID once it has been assigned to you.

List your permanent address in your home country. This is required by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services.

Transcripts should show the individual subjects studied, the marks or grades and number of credits received in each subject for each year, and any certificates, diplomas or degrees awarded. Official copies of all academic records are required. If only the original is available and it would be difficult to replace, a certified copy may be submitted. To be official, this copy must bear the original stamp or seal and signature of a school officer from the original issuing institution or examining board. The seal, stamp, and signature must be placed on the copy after photocopying. Copies certified by a consulate, embassy, military, notary public or other parties are NOT acceptable. For Indian marksheets we accept only certified copies of the original, complete University marksheets, not marksheets that have been retyped and consolidated by affiliated colleges. Individual transcripts from each school attended are required. If the original language of the record is not English, a certified English translation must be attached.

Failure to list any colleges as instructed will result in expulsion from the University. If the space provided is not sufficient, list additional schools on a separate sheet.

Former OU students should list schools attended **since** leaving the University of Oklahoma including current and anticipated enrollment. Send official transcripts from all colleges or universities you have attended **since** leaving OU. If you have not attended any colleges since leaving OU write NONE in the first block.

Indicate "YES" or "NO" if you will have completed 24 hours of college-level (non-remedial or E.L.S.) coursework or a bachelors degree or higher degree from an accredited college in the United States or a country where English is the native language.

Confidential Financial Statement

This page must be completed and returned with your application showing available funds. If you will be supported by someone other than your immediate family, please ask your sponsor to submit a letter indicating the U.S. dollar amount of their support. Please be sure to sign and date the bottom of the CFS.
