

Entrepreneurship minor for non-business majors will be restricted to no more than 30 new students per year.

Application Process

1. Student must have a 3.0 retention combined grade point average or better at the time of application.
2. Students must have completed or be concurrently enrolled in the required lower division courses for the minor.

Permission to Declare Minor

1. Price College Review Committee will evaluate applicants. Acceptance into the program will be based on academic performance in courses, activities, awards, work experience, ACT scores, and other measures indicative of future performance. Submit Application online at <http://pcbfaculty.ou.edu/EntMinor/>
2. Accepted students in the minor will be given permission to enroll in the twelve upper-division credit hours of the minor.

Requirements

18 hours. All upper division courses must be completed at OU. Students must progress through the curriculum according to the approved plan of study. No correspondence courses may be taken to fulfill requirements. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass. A minimum of three terms is required to fulfill minor requirements.

Prerequisite: ECON 1123, Principles of Economics – Micro

- FIN 3513, Entrepreneurial Finance
- ENT 3113, New Venture Development I
- ENT 4113, New Venture Development II
- ENT 4603, New Venture Development III
- ENT elective, any ENT course not listed above

Minimum OU and Combined GPA of 2.50 in courses completed in the minor

No single course may be used to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement.

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. If declared and successfully completed, the student's transcript will indicate the minor at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
