The University of Oklahoma Police Department

OUPD is the law enforcement agency for the University of Oklahoma. It serves the Norman, OK campus of over 30,000 students, faculty, and staff. It has the responsibility for investigating crimes and for responding to police emergencies. OUPD provides security for all major special events on the OU campus.

OU Police Officers are armed, CLEET certified peace officers. They may be assigned as patrol officers, detectives, or Crime Prevention Officers. Some are assigned to the multi-jurisdiction SWAT team and to the joint Hazardous Devices Unit.

Starting pay: \$43,264 per year.

Benefits include:

- Step raises based upon training and responsibility;
- Paid vacation and holidays;
- Uniforms and equipment provided;
- Tuition assistance;
- Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System.

Minimum requirements:

- 21 years of age;
- High school or GED;
- Pass background investigation;
- Pass medical physical exam.
